

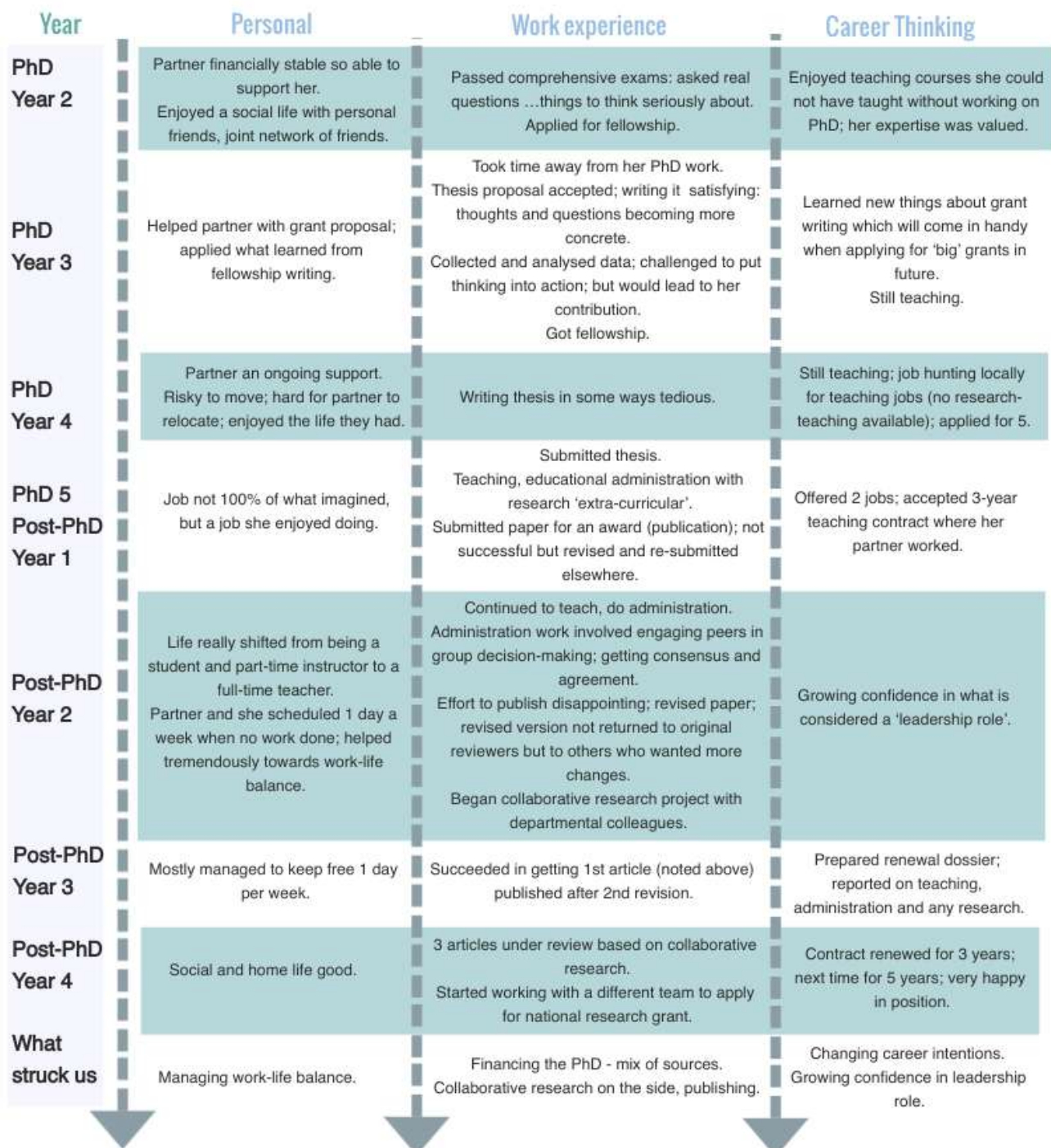
# Apprise Timeline of NANCY
